Top of mind is the Knights of Columbus **Silver Rose**, which will be at St. John Neumann, 44800 Warren, Canton, MI, on **Wednesday, April 14**. Public viewing and veneration will be from **5:00pm to 7:00pm**, with a prayer service to follow. Each year, from early March through mid-December, Silver Roses are stewarded by Knights of Columbus councils along routes from Canada to Mexico. Every stop the Silver Rose makes throughout the pilgrimage is a rosary-centered occasion for Knights, parishioners and community members to pray for respect for life, for the spiritual renewal of each nation, and for the advancement of the message of Our Lady of Guadalupe, promoting respect for life. All Knights and their families, as well as all people, are invited, though masks and social distancing

guidelines need to be observed. Note that our Color Corps, as well as those from two other assemblies, will be watching over the rose.
